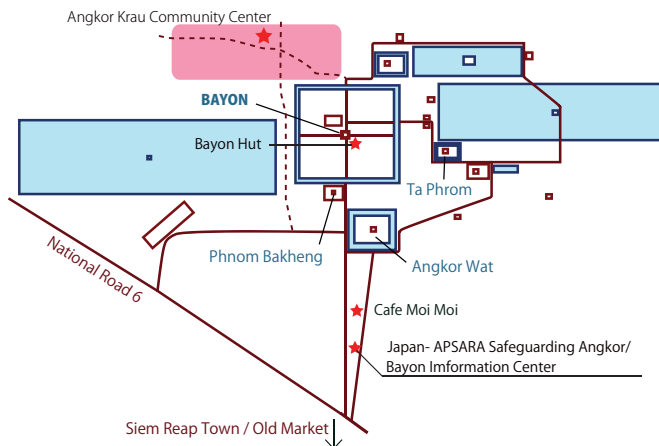

Preservation of Heritage

JST's focus is on public relations for foreign tourists, and educational activities for Cambodian children about the preservation of Angkor heritage. We would like to reintroduce the ancient Khmer construction techniques, and past cultural knowledge to the people who are responsible for the preservation of heritage.

Study trip for Cambodian students



More than 2 million foreigners visit the Angkor archaeological park every year. There are however very few chances for Cambodian children to visit and learn about Khmer history and temples. JST has implemented a program called "School Trip for Cambodian Children". In this program Cambodian restoration experts explain about the ancient techniques and the philosophy of restoration work. We welcome support to implement this program to pass on the Angkor heritage and traditions to coming generations!!

Bayon Hut Reopened!

Bayon Hut reopened in a new location to the south-east side of the Bayon. Visitors can enjoy the latest restoration result and restoration activities on-going at the Bayon by the Japan-APSARA Safeguarding Angkor (JASA) team. The highlights are the replicated ancient construction equipment. You can try the technique used by the ancient people at the site.

Support Children in Villages

Various educational activities, for example, daily English Class and weekly Japanese Class for children in Angkor Krau village, have caused great changes in people's consciousness in the village. In 2011, we have started new activities for children living in more faraway villages.

Nutrition care program

"A Nutrition Care Program for Children in Angkor Krau Village" is becoming more and more enriched. We made fire wood oven for cooking and started cultivation of vegetables in the village. Also, fish farming is under consideration.

Children in the village gradually achieve self-reliance and bring rice and firewood from their house to the Nutrition Care Program site. With this success, JST has started the program for children living in more faraway villages, "A Traveling Nutrition Care Program". The Angkor Krau youth group carries equipment and foods by motor cycle to the villages. The food is cooked rice porridge containing plenty of meat and vegetables. Children are overjoyed with the meals. Vitality of the children encourage the whole village!



School equipment support



We distribute used PCs, school backpacks, stationery, uniforms, and gymnasium shoes, send from Japan, to neighboring elementary school. These items are now precious to the children in Cambodia.

Make Local Society Active

The linkage of support for the local society which started from Angkor Krau by JST has been expanding its scope. JST has moved ahead gradually from infrastructure, to educational programs for children to human resource development of young generations. The foundation to comprehensively design the future of the village is becoming stable.

Reforestation Project of Angkor Area



Up to now, we practice reforestation of the 'Angkor Forest' program mainly around Angkor Krau village. Recently, the youth group visited neighboring elementary schools and gave guidance in environmental education to the student about how to save their environment and protect their health. Schools once littered with trash have changed drastically, and are now cleaned by the village children. Also, we investigate the conditions of local society and, gradually noticed various problem.

JST believes that cooperation with villagers to solve these problems will become a program in the future.

Youth Group growing up!!

The activities of Angkor Krau youth group who are charged to implement the workshop of the reforestation project in Angkor was highly praised by the authorities for education in Siem Reap. They are rapidly growing up though many kinds of experience such as interaction with participates of study tours and internship students, and not only through workshops at primary school. They will be a bridge between local society and the international society in the future.

We also work on environment maintenance of the Teacher Training School in Siem Reap Province. Through making a nursery tree center, and tree planting with student, we trust the future of Cambodia to their hand.
