

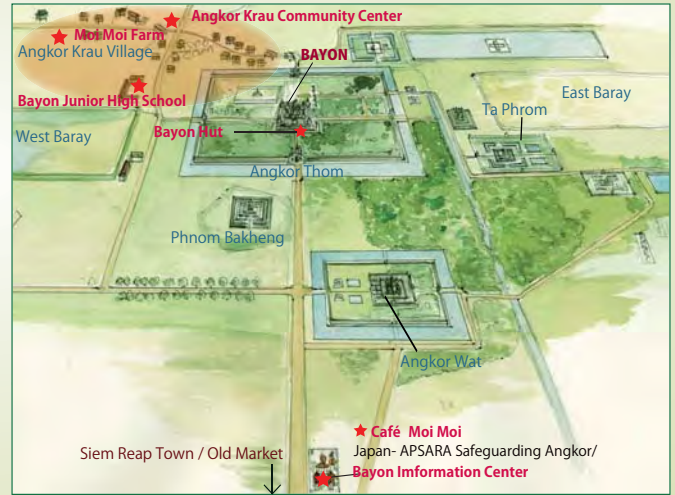
# JST is supporting People living with Heritage.
